Parishioners would like safer, accessible walking, cycling and bus routes in the heart of St John's village. This message is the clear finding from surveys and studies conducted within the parish.

Responding to this, the St Johns Village Improvement Board has developed a series of options to meet the ambition for reducing barriers to active travel within the village. The board would like to understand what the community feels is the best option to proceed with, so they can make a recommendation to the Minister for Infrastructure to seek funding for implementing these improvements.

The options for the community to consider will improve the public experience in St Johns village, enhance road safety, and ensure a cohesive and attractive character in the village.

The Government of Jersey's Sustainable Transport Policy and Bridging Island Plan recognise schemes seeking to advance 'active travel', i.e., cycling and walking, and they aim to prioritise funding for these schemes.
