Every home in St John receives a recycling collection, in addition to the existing rubbish and glass collections. Recycling collections will be on the same day as your glass collection.

- Plastic bottles: red box/bin with red sticker
- Metal packaging: black box/bin with blacksticker

Your glass bin You are required to provide your own bin for glass
