## Household recycling collection 2025

This guide explains how to use the St John household recycling collection. A collection planner is included so you know when your recycling will be collected.

Every home in St John receives a recycling collection, in addition to the existing rubbish and glass collections. Recycling collections will be on the same day as your glass collection.

- **Mixed paper and card:** blue box/bin with blue sticker
- **Plastic bottles:** red box/bin with red sticker
- **Metal packaging:** black box/bin with black sticker
