In closing Le Connetable thanked our team of Officers for the work they do for the Parish and for the States of Jersey Police. He advised the Assembly that he had recently received a letter from the Minister of Justice and Home Affairs thanking the Honorary Police Force for the voluntary work they carry out, and the assistance and support they give the States of Jersey Police.
