All recycling collected in Jersey just gets burned in the Energy Recovery Facility



FACT!



Items sent for recycling through Parish and Government of Jersey collections are not incinerated. Only contaminated materials are diverted for energy recovery.

Some collections rounds use the same type of vehicle, but the loads are kept separate to ensure proper recycling.



You don't need to rinse out food containers or bottles before recycling.





Dirty items can contaminate the whole collection, making them unrecyclable. Always rinse before recycling!

MYTH (



You should leave metal lids on jars and bottles.





Metal lids and tops should be removed and placed with your household metal recycling.



Glass can go in general waste or energy recovery.





Glass can damage the Energy Recovery Facility, leading to costly repairs. It must be recycled properly.



Plastic bottle tops can't be recycled.









Plastic bottle tops can be recycled, so don't throw them away!
